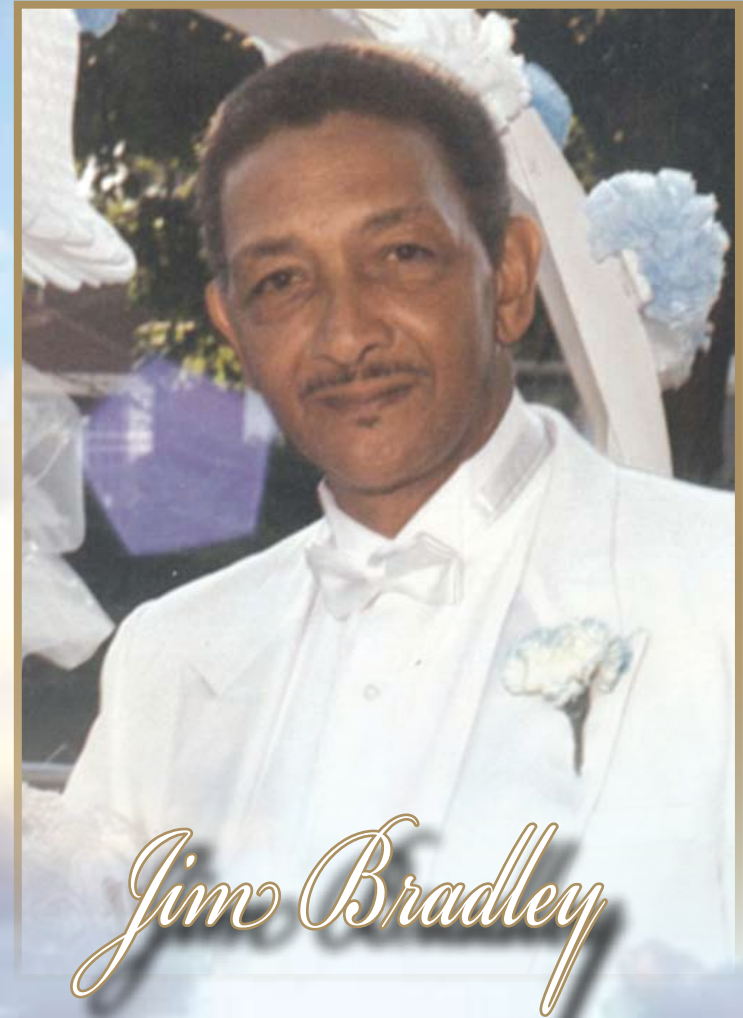


Jim departed this life on Saturday, August 1, 2009 at 4:30 a.m. at St. Joseph Hospital after battling failing health.
